What is LEAD?

Lake Economic Area Development (LEAD) is a nonprofit, public-private partnership created to strengthen, support, and unite the Lake County regional economy. As a 501(c)6, the LEAD partners with local government, chambers of commerce, educational & workforce organizations and other community stakeholders to collectively drive economic growth in Lake County.

LEAD focuses on three main components of economic development:

<u>Business Attraction</u> - Recruiting new primary employers to Lake County with a focus on three Target Sectors: Logistics/Distribution, Manufacturing, Agribusiness.

<u>Business Retention</u> - LEAD recognizes that by focusing on assisting and growing the existing business base in the county, it retains and creates employment opportunities. Among the initiatives provided under this program are Visitation (every industry will receive at least 2 visits a year), industry-focused training opportunities, and a Plant Managers group.

<u>Business Creation</u> - Expanding home-grown opportunities is a major thrust for LEAD. Entrepreneurs not only create employment for themselves, but they provide jobs for others and opportunities for communities. LEAD will build & accelerate the entrepreneurial ecosystem in Lake County by establishing the widely regarded **1 Millions Cups** and **FastTrac® Programs** from the Kauffman Foundation, leading to more direct one-on-one counseling, educational, & networking opportunities for entrepreneurs.
